**MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE**

George and Sharon Terrett have been dancing a total for 25 years. Sharon began dancing in 1970. She has served as club Treasurer, Secretary, Vice-President, and Club Delegate to the Greater Memphis Square and Round Dance Association. In 1975 she was elected as Area I Delegate to the Tennessee State Association of Square and Round Dance Clubs, Inc., and has been involved with this organization ever since including four terms as State Association Treasurer. She worked on the 6<sup>th</sup> Tennessee State Convention as Publicity and Publication Chairman in 1978. George began dancing in 1978. He began attending Tennessee State Association meetings with Sharon and was soon working as an Area I Delegate.

At the 29<sup>th</sup> National Square Dance Convention they served as Chairman of Youth Activities. In 1982 they represented Tennessee in Washington, D.C., lobbying for the enactment of the bill making Square Dance our National Folk Dance. In 1984 they accepted the position of Area I Delegates and George was selected as Area I Vice-President. In 1986 they were Business Manager for the 13<sup>th</sup> Tennessee State Convention. George was the President of the Tennessee State Association of Square and Round Dance Clubs, Inc., from 1986 to 1988 and Sharon was the Membership Chairman.

George is currently President of the Greater Memphis Square and Round Dance Association, the sponsor of the 39<sup>th</sup> National Convention. They are also serving as Program Chairman for the 39<sup>th</sup> National Convention.

They have both served on panels and discussion groups at state meetings and local festivals and have attended a total of eight National Square Dance Conventions.

From the program book of the 38<sup>th</sup> National Square Dance Convention, 1989
